The Master of Ceremonies will be Sue Kwon '86, a ConsumerWatch reporter for CBS 5 Eyewitness News and host of Bay Sunday. Kwon and long-time faculty members will present awards to accomplished alums who have found success in the worlds of business, education, and the arts.

The Spring Gala hopes to reunite the broad base of Eagles who share a connection to their alma mater, Clayton Valley High School.
